
AQABA (PETRA), JORDAN

Aqaba's clear warm waters and vibrant coral reefs are the best in the Red Sea. Add in the lunar-like desert landscapes of Wadi Rum and the ancient pink stone ruins of Petra, Jordan's most precious treasure. Aqaba's Mamluk Castle, an impressive fortress originally built by Crusaders in the 12th century, is also worth a visit. Marvel at the pristine white exterior of Sharif Hussein Bin Ali Mosque along with its intricate glass windows and soaring minarets. Stop by Aqaba's Friday night market, Souk by the Sea, to support local artisans selling handcrafted gifts, clothing and jewellery.



ABU DHABI, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

Abu Dhabi is the capital city of United Arab Emirates and is the Arabian Gulf's gem as it is a modern opulence with a distinct Arabian twist. Although there is a strong sense of Arab culture, a majority of the population are expats. Abu Dhabi is home to one of the world's biggest mosques, the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque - a masterpiece that is made up of white marble with the capacity to allow 40,000 worshippers. The city offers generous promenades and white-sand beaches such as Corniche, Saadiyat and Yas.





ATHENS (PIRAEUS), GREECE

Athens was the heart of Ancient Greece, a powerful civilization and empire, and is still dominated by ancient landmarks, such as the magnificent Acropolis, a hilltop citadel built in the 5th century BC and topped with the colonnaded Parthenon temple. Both the Acropolis Museum and the National Archaeological Museum preserve sculptures, vases and jewellery dating back to Antiquity. A large part of Athens' historic centre has been converted into a 3-kilometre pedestrian zone, leading to the major archaeological sites that reconstruct the ancient landscape.



PENANG, MALAYSIA

Rediscover old-world Asia in the charming and humble streets of Penang.
